RULES:

Entrants must be 2023-2024 sanctioned members of USBC.

OPEN TO ALL ASSOCIATIONS

1. ENTERING AVERAGE as follows:

A. Highest 2022-23 USBC (Fall/Winter) league average based on a minimum of 21 games (Bowl.com). If none, go to B.

B. Current average of 21 games (Fall/Winter or Summer) or more (bring or mail w/entry standing sheet). If none, bowler will bowl scratch.

Rule # 319A Item #2 is in full affect. If current season (not Summer) is 10 pins higher the previous year's, the current average will hold precedent over last year's average.

2. Handicap will be 90% of 230 for all eligible bowlers.

3. Late bowlers will start scoring in the frame in progress upon their arrival, receiving zero for any missed frames.

FALSIFICATION OF AVERAGE MAY RESULT IN THE DISQUALIFICATION OF BOWLER.

4. Bowlers must report to the lanes at least 30 minutes & walk-ins 1 hour prior to bowling.

5. Dry towels and shammy's are only allowed in the bowler's area during the duration of the tournament.

ALTERING THE SURFACE OF A BOWLING BALL BY USE OF ABRASIVES, CLEANERS AND/OR POLISHES IS PROHIBITED

6. During competition including warm up prior to your squad, no substance maybe placed on the outer surface of the bowling ball.

7. No modifications can be made to affect the balance of the ball once competition has begun (1st frame of first game).

PENALTY:

1ST OFFENSE: WARNING **2ND OFFENSE: DISQUALIFICATION.**

Any protest regarding scores or eligibility shall be made to the tournament director within 72 hours.

TOURNAMENT DIRECTORS' DECISION IS FINAL UNLESS AN APPEAL TO USBC IS FILED.

NO REFUNDS WILL BE MADE ONCE THE ENTRY HAS BEEN PROCESSED.

ANY RULES NOT MENTIONED IS COVERED BY THE USBC RULEBOOK.
